


Q.1: How often do teachers encourage you to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?


Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?






Q.6: How often do students at your school have important conversations about race, even when they might be uncomfortable?













Q.8: How wrong do you think it is for someone your age to drink alcohol?





Q.9: How wrong do you think it is for someone your age to use marijuana?THC products?











Q.13: How often do you see students driving or riding in a car or other vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol?








Q.2: Overall, how high are your teachers' expectations of you?





Q.3: How often do you have opportunities to demonstrate your understanding in a way that's different from a test or quiz?







Q.1: During the past 12 months, how many times have you moved?




Q.3: During the past 30 days, how often did you go hungry because there was not enough food in your home?








Q.5: During a typical day, how many hours do you spend on a media device for a purpose other than homework (for example phone, gaming system, computer, laptop/tablet)?






Q.7: The new cell phone policy has improved the school environment.



Q.8: On an average school night, how many hours of sleep do you get?










Q.7: During the last 12 months, how often does feeling sad, hopeless, worried or anxious prevent you from wanting to come to school?




Q.8: During the past 12 months, have you been concerned enough about your weight or body image that you have engaged in self-destructive behaviors?




Q.9: During the past 12 months, have you ever hurt or injured yourself on purpose (without meaning to end your life)?









Q.2: How positive or negative is the energy of the school?




Q.3: How pleasant or unpleasant is the physical space at your school?

Q.4: At your school, how unfairly do the adults treat the students?









Q.5: How fair or unfair are the rules for the students at your school?




Q.6: At your school, how much does the behavior of other students hurt or help your learning?



Q.7: How often are people disrespectful to others at your school?




Q.8: Students at my school are respected and valued regardless of race/ethnicity, gender identity/expression, sexual orientation, income level, learning differences, or any other differences.






Q.1: I know what to do in case of an emergency at my school.



Q.2: How often do students get into physical fights at your school?




Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?










Q.7: If a student is bullied in school, how difficult is it for them to get help from an adult?











Q.2: How much do you matter to others at this school?




Q.3: How much respect do students in your school show you?



















Q.4: When your teachers ask how you are doing, how many of them are really interested in your answer?



Q.5: How many of your teachers would you be excited to have again in the future?











