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\*\* Clubs on this pay schedule are referred to as "student-initiated interest groups" in LPS school board policy. A Teacher may request that an existing club, which is Teacher-directed and conducted outside of school hours, be reclassified and moved onto the activity pay schedule by contacting the school's principal or designee, the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources, and the Association President. If the principal/designee, Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources and Association President agree that the club shall be moved onto the activity pay schedule, it shall enter the activity pay schedule at the "Entry Level" pay level. Movement up the activity pay schedule to a higher pay level shall only occur via the negotiated process, so that information can be gathered regarding the Teacher's time commitment related to the activity, in comparison with other existing activities.
